

## Boxes with pandoc-latex-environment and tcolorbox

This example demonstrates the use of the filter `pandoc-latex-environments` to create custom boxes with the `tcolorbox` package. `pandoc-latex-environment` is a pandoc filter for adding LaTeX environment on specific HTML div tags. Markdown formatting inside the environment is supported.
